11.10.040 Vacancies.

"(a) Except for a vacancy in the office of mayor, a vacancy on the assembly shall be filled by the assembly which shall appoint by majority vote of the remaining members a qualified resident of the election district from which the vacancy arose to be the acting assemblymember until the next regular election and a successor is elected. The person appointed by the assembly shall be compensated in accordance with CBJ 11.15.050(b)." ...

Individuals wishing to be considered for the upcoming vacant District 1 Assembly seat are asked to complete the below form and attach a letter of interest and resume and submit it to the Municipal Clerk's office at the above address by January 2, 2019.

- I am a qualified voter as required by law; and
- I am a resident of the City and Borough of Juneau, and will have been a resident for at least one year immediately preceding the date of this appointment; and
- I am a resident of Assembly District 1; and
- I am not an employee of Bartlett Regional Hospital, the City and Borough of Juneau or any municipal board, commission, committee or other group, except for the school district, nor any public body created by the Assembly; and
- If appointed, I will not hold any other compensated municipal office or employment or elected partisan political office while serving on the Assembly.
- If I am appointed, I agree to file the required Alaska Public Officials Financial Disclosure statement in accordance with AS 39.50.



Dear CBJ Assembly,


